Euro-Disney Golf Clubhouse Marne-la-Vallée, France




EuroDisney's Golf Clubhouse is initially experienced as an object on the horizon. Three distinct roof forms—a dome, a barrel vault and a curved, segmented shed—distinguish the primary programmatic volumes in contrast to the natural setting.

Connecting the separate site and building circulation systems, the vehicular entry porch with a skylighted canopy extends through the building as the public access gallery.

The 11,000-square-foot ground floor houses locker rooms, a store, a restaurant-bar and kitchen, and administrative offices. Two large exterior terraces provide ground-floor views to the golf course. The 9,500-square-foot lower level accommodates parking and service for 120 golf carts, staff support space, and a vehicular ramp from grade.
